Serenity Hills is a therapeutic place of residence designed to help individuals with chemical dependency and dual-diagnosis continue the journey of recovery, healing, and wholeness. We are unable to accept sex offenders due to mixed gender environment.

ADMISSION PROCESS

[1] **Complete application** and return to Serenity Hills. If your application is considered we will need the following records for acceptance into our program:

- Chemical Dependency Evaluation.
- Psychiatric/Psychological Evaluation is required.
- TB test result (must be within the past 6 months) **If you have had a positive TB reading in the past, an x-ray and/or doctor's statement is required indicating TB is non-reactive. The x-ray and the doctor's statement must be within the past year.**
- Physical exam report (must be within the past 3 months)
- List of current medications and doses, **copy of orders and prescriptions**
- Copy of 2 forms of identification
- Copy of Insurance/Medicare/Medicaid cards
- Copy of Court Order (if applicable)
- Discharge Summary from most recent Drug/Alcohol or Mental Health Treatment

Applications will not be considered for acceptance unless Serenity Hills application, Chemical Dependency Evaluation, Psychiatric/Psychological Evaluation and Physical Exam Report have been submitted.

[2] Serenity Hills Coordinator approves application.

[3] If accepted, the Dual Diagnosis application is sent to Division of Mental Health and Division of Drug, and Alcohol for **preauthorization, unless referring agency has preauthorized.**

[4] The Coordinator will **contact** the referent or applicant with approval or denial of admission.

[5] An **admission date** will be assigned or name placed on our waiting list.

LENGTH OF STAY

Recommended length of stay is six months to one year. This may vary according to individual need.

PERSONAL EFFECTS

What to bring:

Seasonal, casual clothing
Personal hygiene items
Music with earphones

Small amount of spending money
Laundry soap

Nicotine, if you use
Alarm clock

Medications – At least 2-4 weeks supply

Items **NOT** allowed:

Any form of weapon
Pornographic material
Boom box or stereo
Computers

Any items that are obscene or promote violence
Any item that promotes the consumption of drugs or alcohol
Cell phone until green level
